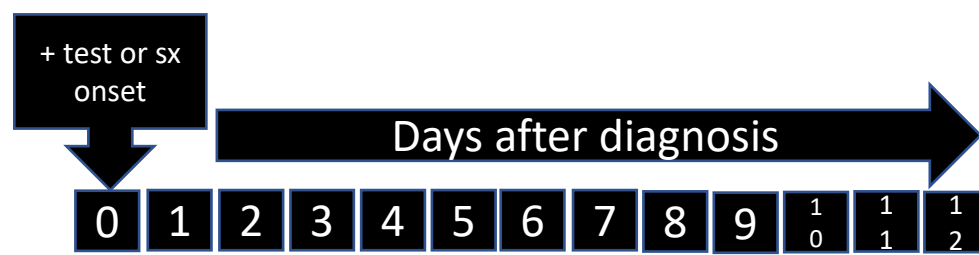
Guidance for COVID-19 positive persons

First day of symptoms or test positivity = Day 0
 Masking must be with KN95 or N95 during the 10 day period
 Self-monitor for symptoms and seek re-evaluation from Campus Health if symptoms recur or worsen
 If symptoms persist beyond 10 days, contact Campus Health for further evaluation and guidance

Examples for infected persons

- Asymptomatic
- Symptomatic for 3 days then asymptomatic
- Symptomatic for 7 days then asymptomatic
- Symptomatic for 10 days

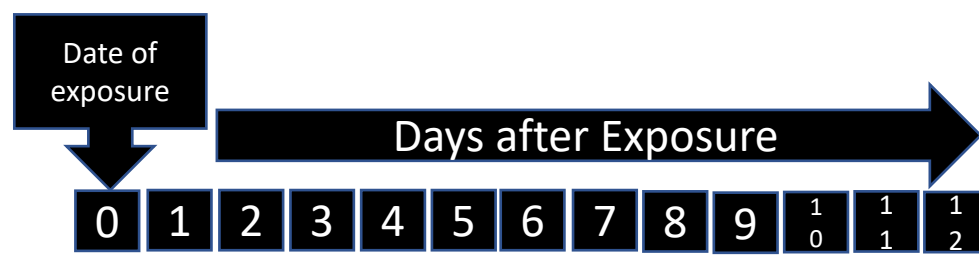
First day of exposure = Day 0

Masking must be with KN95 or N95 during the 10 day period after exposure

Self-monitor for symptoms and seek re-evaluation from Campus Health if symptoms develop

Examples for exposed persons

- Asymptomatic, unboosted
- Asymptomatic, unboosted, critical HCW
- Asymptomatic, boosted
- Symptomatic on day 4, boosted
